I was born in 1945 and after my time in school I attended a seminar for Kindergarten Teachers. From 1965 - 1969 I worked in several Children's Homes. From 1969 - 1972 I studied at a Pedagogic High School and since then I have been working as a teacher at Primary and Secondary Schools. my main subjects are German and English.

Besides school work I dealt with work in Teacher's Union and Women's Liberation movement, and was organizing vocational groups for teachers.

I was meeting Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh at a time when I was looking for some kind of values I hadn't experienced before.
