

Correspondence Italy, July 23rd 1983

To whom it may concern,

I would like to tell you how I came to know Bhagwan and why I became one of His samyaginis and why I am still one of them.

Four years ago I had a sport shop in Italy and after five years of work I was completely bored; so I decide to sale everything and going to visit Bhagwan in India because I had read a book of Him and I founded something incredible beautiful in it; I went there and after a while I "decide" to become a samyagini, it was in 1980.
